

Mr. Pretari's 5 Simple Rules and Expectations

- 1. **BE PROMPT** --- To be in class on time (before the bell) and to take a seat.
- 2. **BE PREPARED** --- To have the necessary materials for the start of class. Be ready to be productive. (ie. textbook, notebook, folder/binder, pen/pencil, etc.)
- 3. BE RESPECTFUL --- Towards others (ie. peers, teachers/staff, substitutes, guests), school, and property.
 - To not be a disruption to the educational process that may inhibit fellow students from learning, the teacher teaching, etc.
 - To not use abusive/profane language, harassment of any kind, etc. but not limited to the above, toward a staff member or fellow students.
 - To not use, any electronic device (i.e. CDs, cellular phones, beepers) but not limited to the above, in school without the permission of the school administration. Also prohibited, but not limited, are the uses of: texting, face time, picture taking, any kind of social media, etc. If in doubt, check it out.
 - > To not eat food or drink in the classroom, unless otherwise told.
- 4. **BE A GOOD LISTENER** --- To follow all directions the first time they are given.
- 5. **BE RESPONSIBILE** --- For your own actions and behavior, as outlined in the student handbook/planner. UCS Board of Education policies and, in some instances, state laws establish behavioral expectations and outline consequences of behavioral infractions.

STRIKE	* Date, noted nature of the same or different infraction
TWO	listed on the Student Referral Form
	(unless insubordination or severe)
	- sentences or discipline packet and/or action plan
	issued related to infraction
	- phone call to student's First Contact (or other)
	- filed with teacher (unless insubordination or severe)
STRIKE	* Date, noted nature of the same or different infraction
THREE	listed on the Student Referral Form
	- phone call to student's First Contact (or other)
ΛΛΛ	- referral turned in to Administration for disposition
